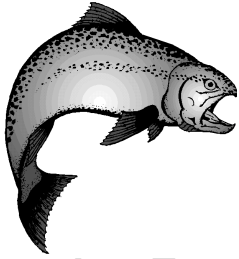

CONSERVATION PROJECT

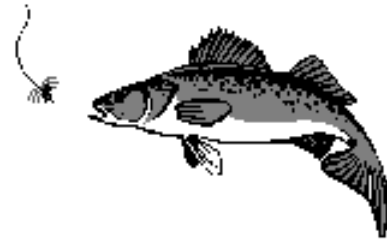

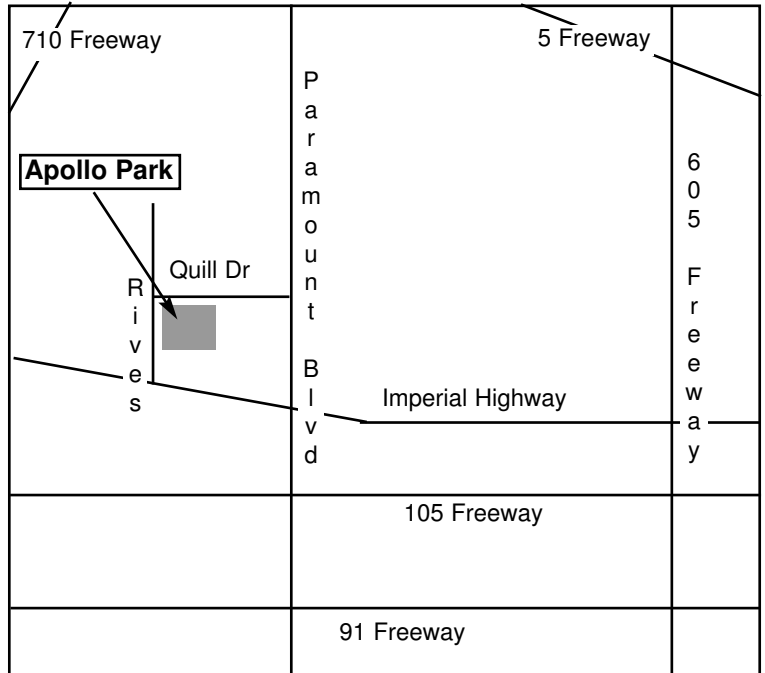
