

San Diego Bay offers one of the greatest fisheries in Southern California with the primary catch being spotted bay bass. However, the Pacific Bonefish is abundant in the bay and is the game fish of choice. Bob purchased his boat in 2007 and is equipped with a depth/fish finder, GPS and the all important stripping baskets in the bow and stern.
