Southwest Council FFF: “Trout in the Classroom” Fund

A joint fund with \$1,000 in “seed money” has been established collaboratively by California Trout and the Southwest Council Federation of Fly Fishers to bring Trout in the Classroom to local area elementary schools.

Trout in the Classroom (TIC) is a hands-on environmental education program in which students in grades K through 12 raise trout from eggs to fry, learn to monitor tank water quality, engage in stream habitat study, learn to appreciate water resources, begin to foster a conservation ethic and grow to understand ecosystems.

“While TIC is designed for grades K through 12, it seems best suited for the 5th grade. Activities include: science and art projects, journaling, measuring, math skills, and visual and language arts. TIC crosses all scholastic disciplines and results in stronger understanding of math, science and social studies,” according to Rich Bollinger, Southwest Council FFF volunteer coordinator.

”The enthusiasm of students and teachers involved in TIC is manifest in the amazing variety and number of activities and projects. Not only are teachers using TIC in the classroom, sometimes whole schools and even communities turn out for the release. Some have made release day a ‘mini-Earth Day,’ with educational booths, field projects, river clean-up and more,” said Nica Knite, CalTrout Regional Coordinator.

Trout in the Classroom projects will be funded one-third by the combined Southwest Council FFF and California Trout fund, one-third by the class participating in the program and one-third by a local fly-fishing club.

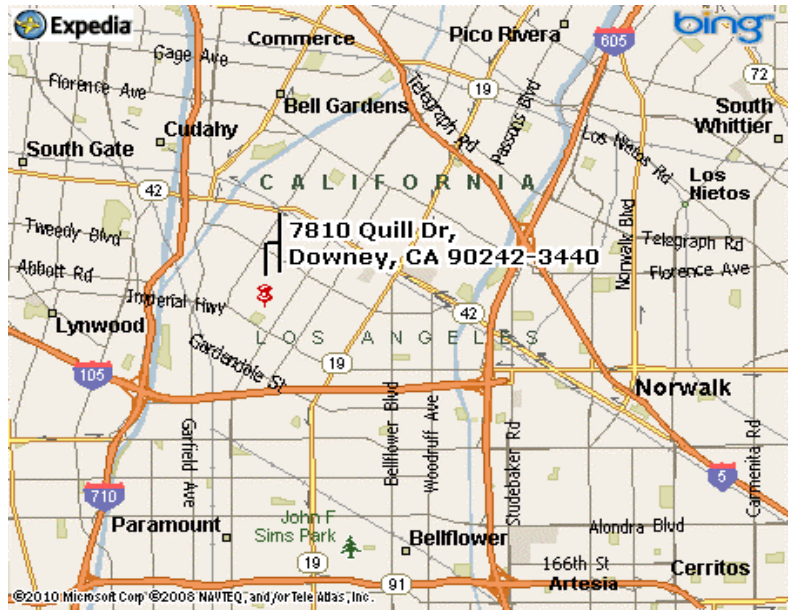
