Two (morning & afternoon) 2 hour sessions. Separate beats in the 20 mile section on the upper Kern. Switching club participants with club controllers is allowed for the afternoon session.

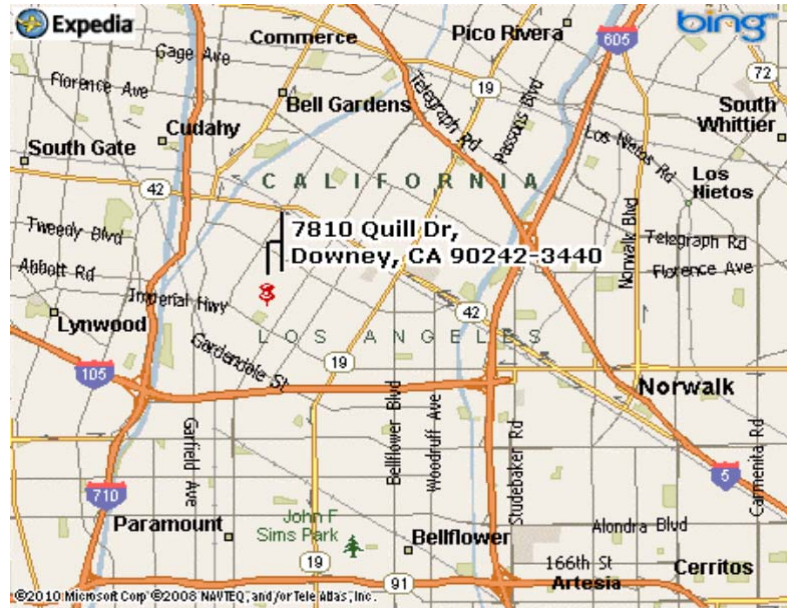
