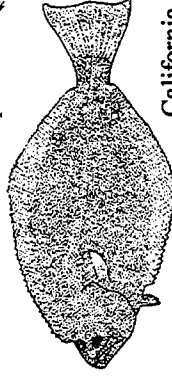
white seabass
